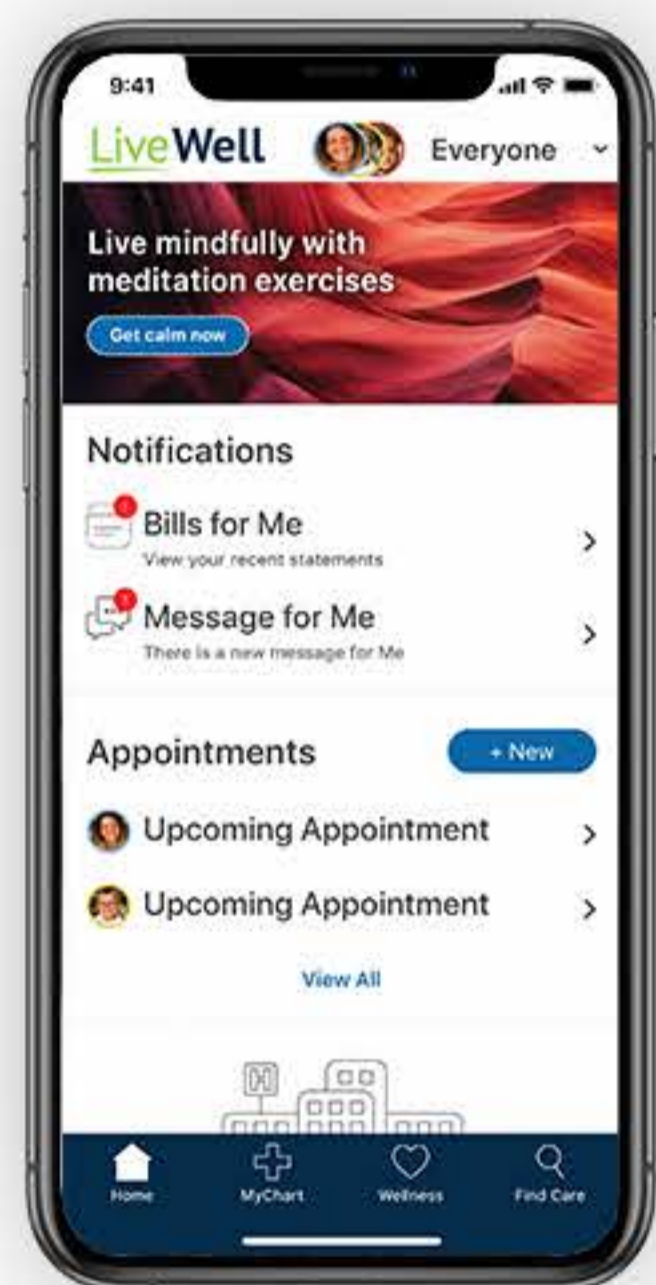

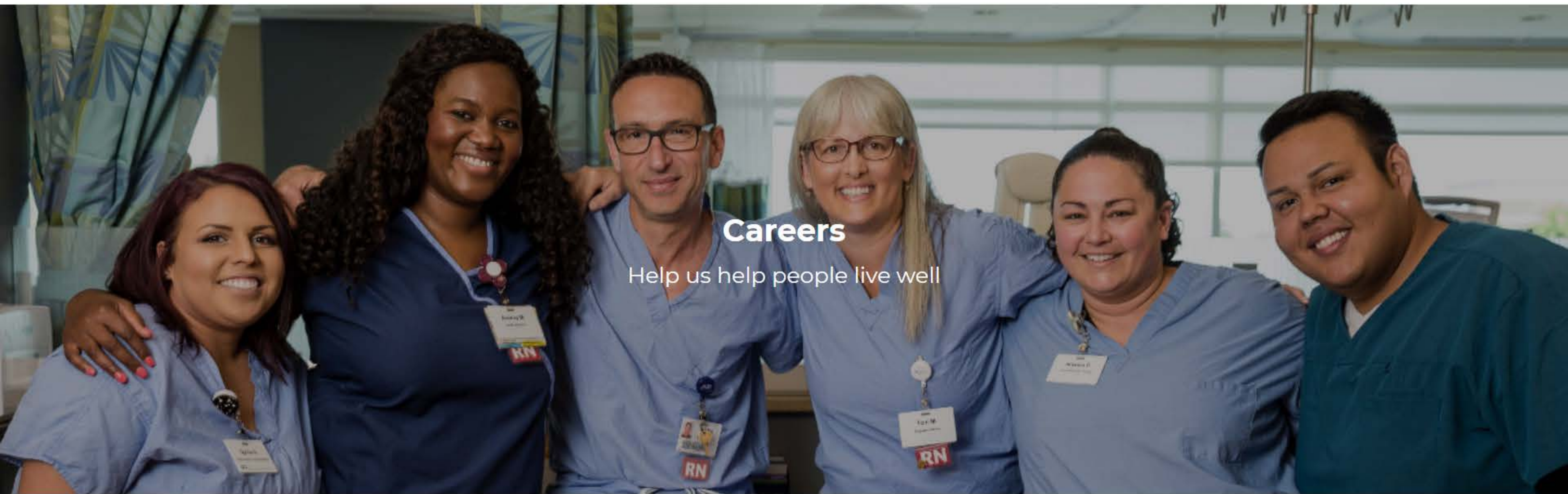

Downers Grove, IL and Milwaukee, WI – In recognition of performance in clinical outcomes, operational efficiency, patient experience and financial health, Advocate Aurora Health hospitals have once again been named to the Fortune/IBM Watson Health™ 100 Top Hospitals List.

Three of the system's hospitals – Advocate Illinois Masonic Medical Center in Chicago, Advocate Sherman Hospital in Elgin and Aurora Medical Center in Kenosha – were among only 11 Illinois and Wisconsin hospitals to achieve the recognition.

"Now more than ever, it is clear our physicians, nurses and team members deliver an extraordinary level of high-quality care every single day," said Jim Skogsbergh, president and chief executive officer of Advocate Aurora Health. "In the face of a pandemic, they doubled down on our relentless commitment to safety, health outcomes and the patient experience to ensure safe, comfortable and convenient care, taking additional measures to protect patients and their families."

To make IBM Watson Health's elite group, hospitals must not only provide the best possible patient care, but must also demonstrate excellence as an efficiently run business. The list was established to help identify best practices that may help other health care organizations achieve consistent, balanced and sustainable high performance.

This recognition demonstrates the three hospital sites' ongoing commitment to patient-centered care, particularly during this very disruptive and challenging time. According to IBM Watson Health, the hospitals included on the Fortune/IBM Watson Health 100 Top Hospitals list had better results on key clinical and operational performance indicators when compared to similar hospitals. These indicators include survival rates, patient complications, healthcare-associated infections, 30-day mortality and 30-day hospital-wide readmission rates, length of stay, throughput in emergency rooms, inpatient expenses, profitability and ratings from patients.

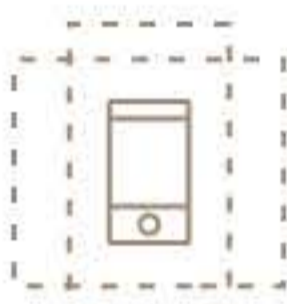
